What fire codes does the Fire Protection District enforce?

The District has adopted 2015 International Fire Code

Are there fees for plan reviews?

Yes, please refer to "Plan Review Fees Document" located on Fire Prevention/Builders FAQ information page of the website.

Are sprinklers required in all buildings?

Sprinklers are required in all new buildings and any existing building that undergoes a "change in use". For example, if a building formerly was used as an office and now, someone is planning on using it as a store that is a change in use that would require sprinklers.
