

Residents: Frequently Asked Questions

What is my ISO rating?

If you are in the Minooka Fire Protection District's area and live in:

Village of Minooka: 4

Village of Channahon: 3

Unincorporated: 6

How do I get a copy of my fire report or ambulance report for my insurance?

You must fill out the proper paper work. Click on the black box labeled "FOIA" on the right side of our website's home page to download the forms needed.

Can I bring my child/or group to tour the fire station?

Yes, but an appointment must be made first. Please call Cindy Wilson, Fire and Life Safety Educator, at 815.467.5637 ext. 112. The tour lasts approximately 30 minutes.

Can a fire engine come to our block party?

Yes. There is a Fire Department Request Form that accompanies the block party paper work with the Village. You can also download the form from our website (look for the picture of a fire engine on right side of the home page). We have to limit our visits to one hour. Due to in climate weather or an emergency response, we may have to cancel last minute.

Can we have a birthday party at the fire station or have the fire engine come to our house for a birthday party?

No and No, but you may make an appointment to bring the kids for a tour.

I bought a new swimming pool. Can the fire department fill it?

No. We do not provide this service.

My son/daughter is in high school and is interested in being a firefighter. Do you have a Cadet program?

Yes, if you live within the Minooka Fire District, are between 16 and 18 years old and maintain a "C" average in school. The Cadet Application can be downloaded from our website under "Careers". Once the application is filled out, bring to the Administration Office at 7901 E. Minooka Rd., Minooka, IL 60442, Monday through Friday, 8am-4pm.

How do I become a firefighter with the Minooka Fire Department?

You must be at least 18 years of age, in good physical condition (able to pass a medical physical and physical agility test) and live within the Minooka Fire Protection District. Once you have completed the application stage and passed your physical requirements you will be placed in an orientation program that teaches you all about our operation. Volunteer Applications can be downloaded from our website under "Careers". Once the application is filled out, bring to the Administration Office at 7901 E. Minooka Rd., Minooka, IL 60442, Monday through Friday, 8am-4pm.
